Columbiana	City of Columbiana	Main Street & Park Avenue Roundabout	2028	Retrofit the intersection of Main Street & Park Avenue from a traffic circle to a single lane roundabout control. Work includes a central island, splitter islands in the approaches, and new crosswalks and ramps for pedestrians.	\$1,303,780
Fayette	City of Washington Court House	US 62 & US 22 Signals	2028	Update the detection of various traffic signals to radar detection along US 62 & US 22 within the City of Washington Court House. Work also includes replacing the controllers and replacing the interconnects with GPS clocks.	\$600,000

Hardin	City of Kenton	Detroit Street Reconstruction	2028	Full depth reconstruction of Detroit Street from Eliza Street to the North Corporation Limit. Work also includes curb ramps, storm sewer improvements, and waterline replacement.	\$2,000,000
Huron	City of Norwalk	West Main Street (SR 61) Phase 4 Rehabilitation	2029	Rehabilitate West Main Street from Cortland Street to Newton Street. Work also includes storm sewer replacement, new curb ramps, new sidewalks, and upgraded pedestrian crossings.	\$2,000,000
